

• Staffs:

The overall objective of the scheme is educational extension and service to the community. It is a student-centered program in which projects are implemented by the NSS volunteers in the community in close collaboration with the community and thereby it provides vast scope to the student's interaction with the people and society. The college has a 100 students unit. The students are involved various activity Tree Plantation, Blood Donation Campaign & Camps, Cleanliness camp, health awareness and women empowerment. Under regular activities, students are participated in AIDS Day, Voter Day, Anti Tobacco/Drug Campaign, Road safety campaign. Special residential camps are conducted every year in adopted village to understand the rural socio economic issues and various activities such as Save Girl Abhiyan, AIDS Awareness campaign, Gram Swachhta Abhiyan, construction for water pond, Jal shivar Abhiyan, digging soak peats, drainage cleaning,.

• Discipline:

▶ Cancellation of admission and refund of fee:

Annexure – I

Admission

Rule and Regulations for the academic year

- 1) The application form for admission duly filled in 'should be submitted within 15 days of the date of declaration of the previous examination, Application submitted / received late will not be considered at any cost. The prospectus contains the required application form.
- 2) The following documents should be attached along with the application form.
 - a) Mark list of previous annual examination.
 - b) School leaving certificate (S.L.C.) Transfer certificate (T.C.) in case of new admission to this college. Admission will be confirmed and finalized on submission of original certificates only.
- 3) Final admission list will be put up on the notice board after scrutiny. Admitted students should confirm their admission by paying necessary fees and submitting required certificates/ documents within a week after display of the admission list. Failing to will lead to cancellation of admission and a waitlisted student will be admitted instead.
- 4) A student seeking admission to F. Y. B. Sc should have offered the same stream at the Std. XII.
- 5) Scrutiny will be made on the basis of merit and rules of reservations as laid down by the government.
- 6) No. fee will be refunded in case of cancellation of admission. Admission of the EBC student will not be cancelled and his original documents /certificates will not return unless he pays fees for the sole academic year.
- 7) The schedule and the details of the admission process will be put up on the notice board on proper time.
- 8) The Principal reserves final right with regards to admission





0.157 Maintenance of discipline and good conduct by students

(Under Section 87 and Section 39 (III) of S. P. Pune University Statute, 2016)

1. Every student during term of the course shall be under disciplinary jurisdiction of the Competent Authority which takes appropriate action in case of indiscipline misconduct on part of student.

The ordinance came in force w.e.f. 2016

- 2. **Definitions:** In this ordinance unless the context otherwise requires.
- i) Student means and includes a person who is enrolled as such by the University Affiliated College or Recognized Institutions for receiving instructions and or qualifying for any degree or diploma or certificate of the University.

Note: This includes External Students also.

- ii) Institution means and includes University, Affiliated College or Recognized Institution as the case may inclusive of campus, Hostels; Play grounds, Laboratory, Libraries, Gymkhana thereof
- iii) Competent Authority for the purpose of the ordinance means and includes Head of the Teaching Department of the University Principal of the Affiliated College; Head of the Recognized Institution, for the concerned students as such other persons, vested with the authority by Vice-Chancellor for external students provided in respect of misconduct regarding University exams Executive Council shall only be Competent Authority.
- 3. Obligation of the Student: Every student shall all times.
- i) Conduct him properly.
- ii) Maintain proper behavior
- iii) Observe strict discipline both within the campus of the institution Hostel and also outside, in Buses, Railways / Trains or at Public places or at picnic on Educational Trips arranged by the institution or at playgrounds





- iv) Ensure that no act of this consciously or unconsciously brings the Institution or any establishment authority connected with it into disrepute.
- v) Shall not lodge any complaint or make any representation regarding any matter connected with Institution to press or other outside institution/agency etc. without forwarding the same through the Head of the Connected Institution.
- 4. Any act of a student which is contrary to the provisions of clause (3) shall constitute misconduct and or indiscipline, which terms shall mean and include among other, any or more of the acts jointly or severally mentioned hereinafter namely:
- i) Any act that directly or indirectly causes of attempts to cause disturbance in the lawful functioning of the Institution.
- ii) Habitual un-punctuality in attending lectures, practical tutorials and other courses as may be prescribed.
- iii) Repeated absence from lectures, tutorials and other courses as prescribed.
- vi) Canvassing for accepting contribution or otherwise associating himself with raising of any fund or any collections in cash or in kind in pursuance of any object whatsoever without the previous sanction of the Competent Authority.
- vii) Securing admission in the Institution, to any undergraduate or postgraduate programme or any other course by fabrication or supposition of facts or information.
- viii) Obstruction to any student or group of students in his or their legitimate activities as such whether in the classroom, laboratories, fields.
- ix) Suppressing material information or supply of false information to the Institution, for seeking any privilege.
- x) Possessing or using any fire arms, lethal weapons explosive or

- dangerous or corrosive substances on the premises of the Institution
- xi) Possessing or consuming any poisonous or stupefying drugs or intoxicant in any form in the Institution.
- xii) Ragging, bullying or harassing any student in Institution or outside thereof.
- xiii) Indulging in any act as would cause annoyance, embracement to any other student, or member of the authority of the Institution to staff members or any member of the family of the staff.
- xiv) Conduct, unbecoming of the student, at any meeting or special functions or sports and cultural activities arranged by the Institutions at any other public place.
- xv) Destroying or attempting to destroy or tamper with any official record or document of the Institution.
- xvi) Conduct, unbecoming of the student, at any meeting or special functions or sports and cultural activities arranged by the Institutions at any other public place.
- xvii) Stealing or damaging any farm produce or any property belonging to the Institution, staff member of the institution or any other student.
- xviii) Instigating violence or participating in any violent demonstrations or violent agitation or violent strike in the institution.
- xix) Violation of any or the rules and regulations of the Institution or orders of the Competent Authority.
- xx) Gambling in any form in the Institution.
- xxi) Disorderly behavior in any form or any act specifically forbidden by the Competent Authority.
- xxii) Any act violating any proves
- xxiii) On of the S. P. Pune University statute, 2016 Statutes, Ordinances, Rules made there under.
- xxiv) Convocation in the Court of Law for criminal offence, involving moral turpitude.

- xxv) Any other act not specifically mentioned hereto before which whether by commission or omission, as would in the circumstances of the case be considered by the Competent Authority as an act of misconduct and indiscipline.
- 5. The Competent Authority may impose any one of the following punishments on the students found guilty or misconduct, indiscipline in proportion there of:
- i) Warning/Censure/Reprimand
- ii) Fine not exceeding Rs. 300/-
- iii) Cancellation of the scholarship/award/prize medal, awarded to the students by the concerned Institution, with prospective effect.
- iv) Expulsion from the concerned Institution.
- v) Debarring from admission to a course or courses of study in the concerned Institution.
- vi) Cancellation of the result of the student concerned in the examination of the concerned Institution in which he/she has appeared.
- vii) Rustication from the Institute for the period not exceeding five years.
- 6. If the competent Authority is satisfied that there is a prima-facie case for inflicting penalties, mentioned in clause No. 5, it may itself through other person/persons authorized by it, for this purpose, shall make enquiry in following manner.
- i) Due notice in writing shall be given to the student concerned about his alleged act of misconduct/indiscipline.
- ii) Student charged shall be required within 15 days of the notice to submit his written representation about such charges.
- iii) If the student fails to submit his written representation within specified time limit, the enquiry may be held expert.
- iv) If oral evidence of the witness against students is recorded by the Enquiry Authority, the student charged shall be given an opportunity to cross examine the witness concerned.

- v) If the student charged, desires to see the relevant documents, such of the documents are being taken into consideration or are to be relied upon for purpose of proving the charge or charges, may at discretion of the Enquiry Authority, be shown to him after the notice as provided in subclause(I) above is furnished to him.
- vi) The student charge shall be required to produce documents. If any, in support of his defense. The Enquiry Authority may admit relevant evidence, documentary or otherwise at any stage before the final orders are passed.
- vii) Legal practitioner shall not be allowed to appear on behalf of the student charge, in the proceedings before the Enquiry Authority.
- viii) Enquiry Authority shall record findings on each implication of misconduct or indiscipline, and the reasons for such findings and submit the report along with proceedings to the Competent Authority.
- ix) The Competent Authority on the basis of findings, shall pass such orders as it deems fit.Provided procedure prescribes above need not be followed an all or any of its provisions made in the following circumstances:
- i) When the student charged admits the charges in writing.
- ii) When the order of punishment is to be based on facts which have led to the conviction of the student charged, for the offence involving moral turpitude.
- iii) When the student charged has abscended or for any other reasons it is impracticable to communicate with him.
- iv) If in the opinion of the Competent Authority, a punishment or fine not exceeding Rs. 50/- or Reprimand Censure, Warning is sufficient.

In the punishment of rustication is imposed on a student by Principal of the college / Head of the Dept. / Head of the Teaching Department of such other person in whom the authority is visited by the chancellor for external students, such a student shall be entitled to prefer an appeal to vice-chancellor if the punishment is imposed by Vice-chancellor, student shall be entitled to prefer an on the Executive Council of the University within thirty days of the receipt of the notice of the student.

In respect of such student, Head of the Institution shall maintain record of the punishment.

The Institution shall, on coach occasion of any punishment being imposed on any student, intimate to be sent Under Certificate of Posting, the fact imposition to the parent of guardian student of the address available in the college record.

A copy of these rules shall be supplied to each student at the time of his admission and receipt for the same shall be obtained from the student. This receipt shall from a part of admission of the student.

If any foreign student is admitted for any course, concerned Institution shall send copy of the rules foreign embassy and department of external affairs.

Cautionary Notice

Students are herby cautioned against malpractices at University, Board and other specified examinations. They could note seriously that malpractices at the said examinations lead to the following:

- 1) Cancellation of the examination in the said subject.
- 2) Cancellation of the examination in the other subject.

A student if found copying shall not be allowed to appear for remaining papers and his earlier performance shall be treated as cancelled He / She shall be executed and punished as per University rules. Moreover he/she shall be subject to punishment provided by the Maharashtra University Act No. 2016 Accordingly a student committing malpractice or using any other unfair means shall on conviction be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend to six months or with fine which may extend to five hundred rupees or with both. All offences under this Act shall be cognizable offences and shall be non-available.

Examination

The students should note that 75% attendance is compulsory for theory and practical to become eligible for appearing at the examination.

College will conduct Internal / Term End / Terminal / Tutorial Examinations as per the norms lay down by Savitribai Phule Pune University from time to time. Marks scored in such examinations shall form the basis for grant of terms.

The Standard of passing will be as per the rules and regulations of Savitribai Phule Pune University.

For F.Y.B. Sc. there is an internal examination worth 20 marks and the university examination is of 80 marks.

For S.Y. / T.Y. B. Sc there is semester pattern examination worth 40-10 (i.e. 10 marks for internal assessment).

For F.Y., S.Y. and T.Y. B. Sc. the practical examination worth 80 marks will be conducted annually. 20 marks are reserved for attendance, regular term work, oral etc.

Award of Class for B.Sc. Science

The class will be awarded on the basis of the aggregate marks obtained at the second year and the third year examinations. The class will be awarded as follows:

- (a) Aggregate 70% or more First Class with Distinction.
- (b) Aggregate 60% or more First Class.
- (c) Aggregate 50% or more but less than 60% Second Class.
- (d) Aggregate 40% or more but less than 50% Pass Class. For B.Sc. faculty, principal subject total of S.Y. and T.Y. B.Sc.
